Artpace San Antonio Reopens to the Public in June

SAN ANTONIO, TX (May 19, 2020)—Artpace San Antonio will open to the public, by appointment beginning **Tuesday, June 2, 2020**, (Tuesday–Friday, 10am–5pm; Saturday: 12pm–5pm). The building will open to Artpace members one week earlier beginning Tuesday, May 26, 2020, also by appointment. Please visit Artpace.org to schedule an appointment.

Artpace guests will have the opportunity to be among the first to view the long-awaited exhibitions of work by our three [Spring 2020 International Artists-in-Residence](#), Carlos Castro Arias, Milagros de la Torre, and Daniel Ramos, which will be on view through August 23, 2020. Artpace's celebrated 25th Anniversary exhibition [Visibilities: Intrepid Women of Artpace](#) will also remain on view through August 23. Digital gallery notes are available for all exhibitions in English and Spanish on Artpace.org.

Our staff and guests' safety remain our top priority, and we will be implementing social distancing and safety measures in accordance with the most recent CDC, state, and local government guidelines including the [Greater. SAfer. Together. pledge.](#)

These measures include:

- Guests must schedule their visit to Artpace prior to arrival through our website
- Guests will require face masks and temperature checks at check-in
- Guests must observe social distancing of 6 feet from other parties
- No more than 6 guests will be scheduled for each hourly appointment

Artpace has prepared a safe environment for our visitors and staff by:

- Installing a plexiglass screen at our visitor relations and information desk
- Installing an automatic door at the front entrance and keeping doors opened inside the building
- Installing touchless faucets in the public restrooms
- Providing hand sanitizer throughout the building
- Scheduling common area sanitizing throughout the day
- Implementing guidelines for onsite staff, including temperature checks, face masks, and distance requirements.
